WATERCOLOUR SUPPLY LIST

The instructor highly recommends using professional quality supplies- it makes a big difference. Although she likes to work with what you already have, please make sure to have <u>Arches</u> 140 lb cold press paper (not hot pressed) and consider the colours and brushes as a guideline only.

Paint

Please bring professional quality paint brands. The brands I use are Winsor & Newton, Holbein or Davinci. For beginners who don't want to invest in a lot of paints, you can purchase the 12 colour set of Yarka paints.
