Size 04 and 08 round brushes (your size 04 must come to a good point as we will be lettering with it.)

Crayola wax crayons

Watercolor paint: I'm using sap green, pthathalo blue, ultramarine blue, quinacridone gold, quinacridone violet, cadmium red and black or paynes grey. They are M. Graham brand but you can use whatever brand you have and similar colors are okay too.
